

Patch Wood Farm Barn Rules

Anyone (friends, family, visitors) must have a signed release form prior to passing the main gate. Please sanitize at the picnic table.

Proper foot wear is required for students and visitors passing the main gate.

You are responsible to clean up after yourself and your horse. All hair, manure, and trash must be put in the appropriate area before you leave. If this is not done, lessons will be cut short to ensure proper clean up during the actual lesson time.

You are responsible for the equipment you use as well. All brushes must be put back where you find them, along with whips, girths, boots, saddles, saddle pads, helmets, and bridles. Cross ties need to be fixed if your horse breaks them. If this is not done, lessons will be cut short to ensure proper clean up during the actual lesson time.

No handling of horses or entering paddocks without permission.

No smoking is allowed.

No running, yelling or foul language is permitted.

Children are always welcome but must be supervised by the adult they came with except during the lesson period.

Children not in lessons are not allowed in the barn, paddocks, or dog areas unless given specific permission. They are welcome to stay quietly at the viewing area. (Please note this is a safety issue)

Spectators watching a lesson should remain at the viewing area (bleachers) as to not distract the students or horses.

No dogs allowed - we have plenty.

Lessons will start promptly, please be on time.

All riders are required to wear an ASTM-SEI certified helmet with a secured harness at all times while mounted .

If you are the last person to leave barn, make sure all lights are off and main gate is up.
